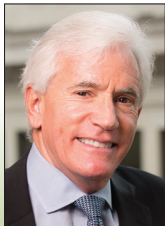

I like to take cases for the underdog, the downtrodden, and the underprivileged in society," he says. "Last year, I had the chance to represent the American farmer in a case against one of the biggest biotech companies on earth—there's no greater pleasure than seeing a jury of 12 people come together to find the truth of a case, and render a verdict that is just, but perhaps against all odds."

During his career, Jamie has tried everything from month-long aviation accident cases, or class actions in federal court to personal injury, automobile and bicycle accidents, and fraud and wrongful death actions in state courts. Some of his cases have involved copyrights, trade secrets, commercial disputes, product failures, employment contract actions, and insurance cases of all types.

Jamie has given lectures to lawyers in 47 states across the country primarily focused on jury psychology and trial presentations and spends time teaching other lawyers and representing indigent clients in pro bono matters. In addition, he is a member of several professional organizations whose mission it is to preserve the right to trial by jury and to enrich the lives of the public through the stewardship of our civil justice system.

CALIFORNIA SAN FRANCISCO**MARY ALEXANDER****Ingebritsen v. City of San Carlos – A \$6,000,000 Dangerous Condition Victory**

This was a survival and wrongful death action brought by Sarah Ingebritsen, her daughter, Eden Ricci and son, Charles ("Charlie") Ricci for the loss of their husband and father, Christopher ("Chris") Ricci, age 53, on April 23, 2016, and for personal injuries to Sarah and Charlie. Causes of action were for dangerous condition of public property, negligence and negligent infliction of emotional distress. Chris was struck and injured by a vehicle driven by Randall Rubingh while walking westbound along the north side of San Carlos Avenue in San Carlos, California. Rubingh was driving under the influence of alcohol at the time. The City was represented by Gregg A. Thornton of Selman Breitman LLP and Rubingh was represented by Timonty W. Workman of Case & Fedor.

Chris subsequently died as a result of his injuries. Sarah was walking with Chris at the time and suffered significant emotional distress. Charlie had just seen his parents walking behind him, and heard the accident from inside their home just yards away. Sarah and Chris had been at a neighbor's house, just a block and a half away from their home. Charlie had been playing basketball with his friends at a neighborhood school.
